- (1) Development likely to have a significant effect on a European Site, when considered alone or in combination with other projects or plans will only be permitted where:
- a) The proposal is directly connected with or necessary for the protection, enhancement and positive management of the site for conservation purposes; or
- Following an appropriate assessment the proposal will not adversely affect the integrity of the site; or
- there is no alternative solution and there are reasons of overriding public interest and appropriate compensatory measures are secured.
- Development likely to have an adverse effect on a European protected species will only be permitted where:
  - a) there are reasons of overriding public interest;
  - b) there is no satisfactory alternative; and
  - c) the action authorised will not be detrimental to the maintenance of the population of the species concerned at a favourable
