

Duration: 1 hour

Length: 2.3 miles (3.7 km)

Public transport: Service bus 361

at Slade Cross (A477) **Grid ref:** SN003047

Character: Woodland, foreshore, unprotected slope, some minor road

walking.

2 gates, 2 footbridges, no stiles. Paths uneven and narrow in places.

From Cosheston village follow signs for playing field and walk past it, staying on road. Just before a pink house go through gate on left onto path through wood. Follow path as it meanders down to a stream. Cross the stone bridge and follow the path down to the river. At the bottom, bear right (do not re-cross the stream) and follow the woodland edge path around. At the end of the wood, turn sharp right (do not cross stile) and follow path. The path turns left at the top to a gate. Pass through gate and continue straight ahead on minor road. At Tjunction turn rights and follow road back to Cosheston.

Caution: Permissive Path between A and B will be closed for shooting during December and January.
