

Length: 3.0 miles (4.8 km)

Public transport: Service bus Amroth 1 km south 350/351/353, Service bus Llanteg 333.

Grid ref: SN155095

There's plenty of opportunity to see woodland flora and fauna in the secluded wooded valleys of Craig-y-borion and Little Craig-y-borion.

Look out for: Fine coastal views, woodland.

Birdlife includes blue tits, great tits, long tailed tits, chaffinch, robin, wren, woodpecker, nuthatch, treecreeper, crow, jay and magpie. Look out for fox, squirrel and rabbit. In good weather there are fine views down the coast and to Caldey Island.

Character: Wooded valleys, farmland.
