

Pantmaenog Half Day + Walk

You are welcome to walk, ride horses and cycle on the signposted forest

tracks. The National Park Authority has agreed with the landowner to provide public access to 12km of forest tracks. Pantmaenog is a privately owned forest managed primarily for timber production.

To fully enjoy your visit and help protect the countryside, please observe the following advice and precautions.



No Access for motor vehicles, motor cycles or quad bikes. It is an offence to drive mechanically propelled vehicles on private land without lawful authority.





Protect plants and animals and take your litter home.



Keep your dog under close control or ideally on a lead.

Caution: weather conditions can change rapidly as paths climb to a height of 1,400 feet above sea level. Please prepare accordingly.

Forestry may be subject to temporary restrictions or closure.
