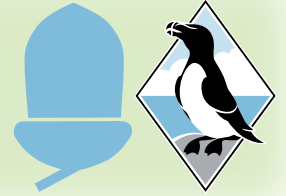


Pembrokeshire Coast National Park

PUBLIC TRANSPORT: Coastal Cruiser (Wheelchair accessible)

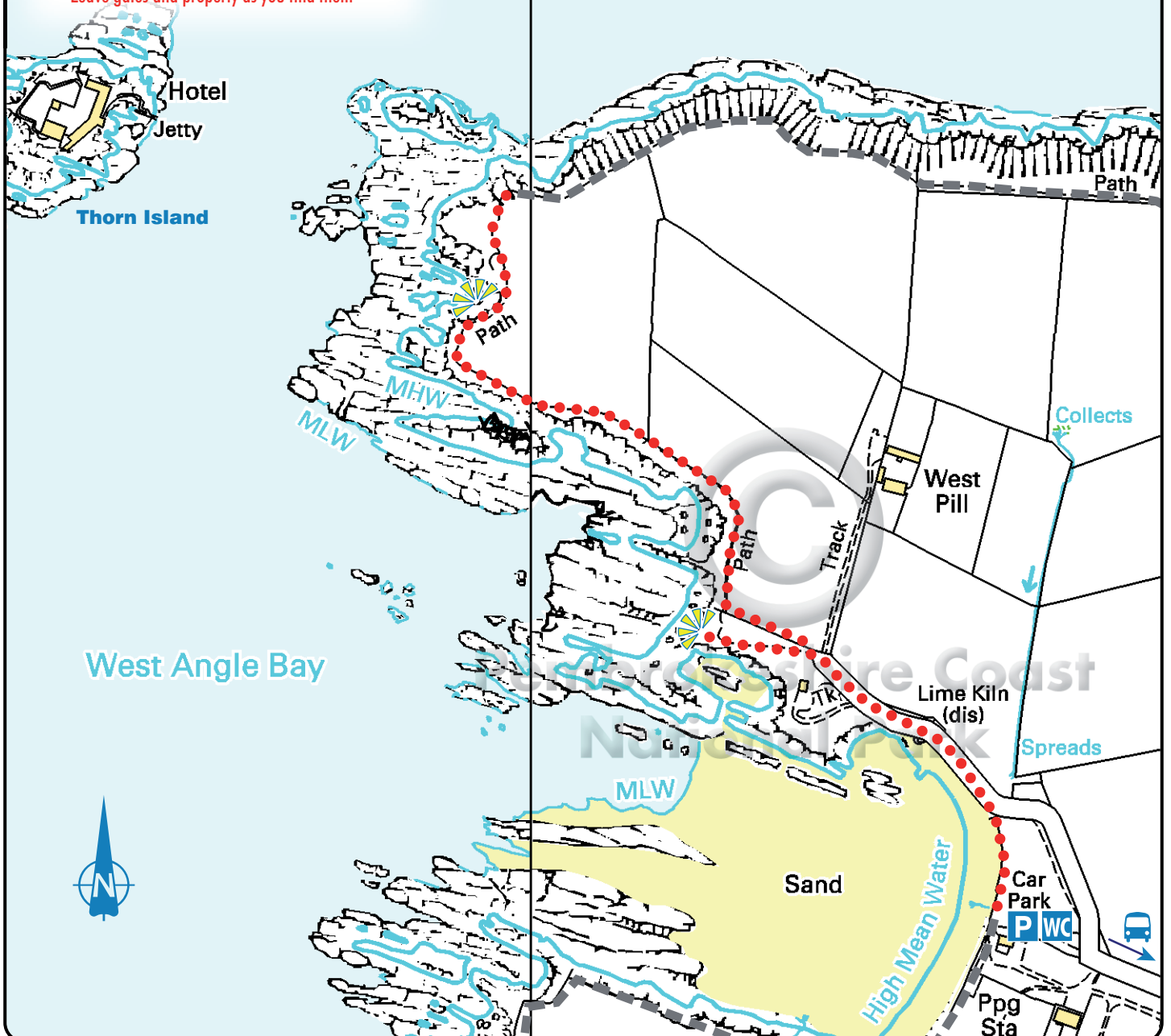
CHARACTER: Mostly field paths of varying gradients

SAFETY FIRST!

Easy Access Walk

Park at free West Angle Bay and go to right past limekilns. From the second junction on the route, turn into the field. Field edge path, grass and earth, soft when wet, gently rising. Steepest gradient is 1 in 15 for 30m in two places. Moderate side slope for 50m. Views of Victorian fort on Thorn Island and across the Haven to St Ann's Head and lighthouse. No seats. Toilets at Freshwater West (not nearby).

Easy Access Path 500 metres
