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Executive Summary

This document is an addendum to the Local Development Plan Sustainability Appraisal (SA) Report.

Changes have been proposed to the Replacement Local Development Plan through the Examination Process, these are set out in the Schedule of Matters Arising Changes (MACs) to the Local Development Plan 2 (Replacement) as submitted in December 2018.

This report assesses these changes through the Sustainability Appraisal process comprising:

- 1. Screening all of the proposed Matters Arising Changes to identify changes where further Sustainability Appraisal is required.
- 2. Carrying out detailed assessment of Matters Arising Changes that have not been 'screened out'
- 3. Considering the overall effect on the Sustainability Appraisal of the Replacement Local Development Plan

The findings of this process are set out in tables 3.1 and 4.2. Sections 4 and 5 provide a summary of the assessments, conclusions and recommendations.

When the Replacement Local Development Plan is adopted, the National Park Authority with publish a Post Adoption Statement for the Sustainability Appraisal that explains how the process has influenced the development of the Replacement Local Development Plan.

This addendum highlights the effects of the proposed Matters Arising Changes have with regard to the Deposit Plan Sustainability Appraisal. Following screening and consideration through detailed appraisals, no implications on the overall Sustainability Appraisal of the Deposit Plan were identified.

1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 As a consequence of the Replacement Local Development Plan Examination process the National Park Authority has considered a series of changes to the Replacement Local Development Plan. These changes are known as Matters Arising Changes (MACs) and are set out in the Schedule of Matters Arising Changes.
- 1.2 Proposed changes to the Replacement Local Development Plan require screening for impacts with regard to the Sustainability Appraisal (SA) and Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) check if they will alter or introduce additional "likely significant effects" beyond those predicted in the Deposit Replacement Local Development Plan Sustainability Appraisal report.
- 1.3 This report provides an Addendum to the March 2018 Deposit Replacement Local Development Plan Sustainability Appraisal Report and identifies if that report should be updated in light of the MACs and how that update would be applied. This report, although an Addendum, should be read in conjunction with the Deposit Sustainability Appraisal Report (March 2018).
- 1.4 This document contains the following:
 - A screening of the Matters Arising Changes to see if they 'materially' change what was assessed in the Deposit Sustainability Appraisal Report.
 - A detailed assessment where screening has indicated this is required.
 - Conclusions and recommendations setting to clarify where references in the Deposit Sustainability Appraisal Report should be changed and consideration of any potential significant effects on the overall Sustainability of the Plan which would result from the proposed Matters Arising Changes.

2.0 Context

- 2.1 Sustainability Appraisal is a statutory requirement for Local Development Plans under Section 62(6) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. The purpose of Sustainability Appraisal is to assess the social and economic effects of the component policies, proposals and strategy elements of the Local Development Plan to ensure that decisions accord with the principles of sustainable development.
- 2.2 Accordance with the sustainable development principle is defined in the Well-being of Future Generations Act (Wales) 2015:

"In this Act, any reference to a public body doing something "in accordance with the sustainable development principle" means that the body must act in a manner which seeks to ensure that the needs of the present are met without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs" (Section 5:Sustainable Development Principle (1)).

2.3 The Welsh Government define sustainable development in Wales through the Well-being of Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015 as:

"the process of improving the economic, social, environmental and cultural well-being of Wales by taking action, in accordance with the sustainable development principle, aimed at achieving the well-being goals" (a more comprehensive description of the Act, its goals and how the Sustainability Objectives contribute to them can be found in Section 5 of the Sustainability Appraisal Scoping Report (June 2016).

2.4 For the purposes of land use planning, the Planning (Wales) Act 2015 performs a function as part of carrying out sustainable development in accordance with the Well-being of Future Generations Act (Wales) 2015

"...for the purpose of ensuring that the development and use of land contribute to improving the economic, social, environmental and cultural well-being of Wales" (Part 2 Sustainable Development, 2(2)).

- 2.5 The Welsh Government Local Development Plan Manual indicates that a Sustainability Appraisal must integrate the requirements of the Strategic Environmental Assessment Regulations. The requirements of EU Directive 2001/42/EC (also known as the SEA Directive) have been transposed into Welsh Law through The Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes (Wales) Regulations 2004. Strategic Environmental Assessment requires the formal assessment of certain plans and programmes that are likely to have significant effects on the environment; this includes Local Development Plans.
- 2.6 The National Park Authority has a duty under the Equality Act 2010 to assess the impact of its policies on different population groups to ensure that discrimination does not take place and where possible, to promote equality of opportunity. This has been carried out through an Equality Impact Assessment (EqIA).
- 2.7 TAN 20 states that the Sustainability Appraisal should assess evidence of the impacts of the spatial strategy, policies and allocations on the Welsh language whilst the Planning (Wales) Act 2015 contains provisions relating to the consideration of the Welsh language in the appraisal of development plans.
- 2.8 Health Impact Assessment (HIA) is not a statutory requirement; however, health considerations are a requirement of the Strategic Environmental Assessment process and thereby the overall Sustainability Appraisal process.

3.0 Screening of Matters Arising Changes

- 3.1 As a consequence of the Replacement Local Development Plan Examination process the National Park Authority has considered a series of changes to the Replacement Local Development Plan. These changes are known as Matters Arising Changes (MACs) and are set out in the Schedule of Matters Arising Changes.
- 3.2 The Matters Arising Changes proposed have the potential to change the assessment of likely effects on social, economic and environmental factors. However, the majority of the changes proposed are minor or related to updates, references or clarifications and are not significant in terms of their impact on the Sustainability Appraisal.
- 3.3 Table 3.1 below sets out the initial Sustainability Appraisal screening of all of the Matters Arising Changes in order to identify those that could have significant effects. Each of the proposed Matters Arising Changes have been compared against the Deposit Plan policies and supporting information to check if the original policy provisions have been changed and if the Deposit Plan Sustainability Appraisal assessments or assumptions still remain valid.

4.0 Detailed Assessment of Matters Arising Changes

- 4.1 Following on from the Sustainability Appraisal screening process carried out in Section 3 of this report, those Matters Arising Changes that have been 'screened in' require more detailed assessment. This done by assessing those changes to the Plan against the framework of Sustainability Appraisal Objectives.
- 4.2 A total of two Matters Arising Changes were identified as being substantive changes to the plan, which may change the likely significant effects that were previously identified for the plan.

4.3 From the removal of criteria (a) from Policy 7 (Countryside) there is potential for some minor positive impacts with regards to emissions from private car use since this change restricts

development in the countryside. There is also potential for minor negative impacts but these are more uncertain since they concern the very limited ability for infill development to contribute to social and cultural aspects.

- 4.4 The new policy for affordable housing exception sites scores well against the SA objectives relating to landscape, communities and reducing the need to travel.
- 4.5 These two changes would not substantively change the quantum of development in the National Park as they deal with very specific development types. Infilling and round off developments are very small in nature and Affordable Housing Exception Sites are of infrequent occurrence. It is considered that there would be no overall impacts to the Sustainability Appraisal of the Replacement Local Development Plan.

5.0 Conclusions

- 5.1 This addendum highlights what effects the proposed Matters Arising Changes to the Local Development Plan as submitted for Examination are likely to have with regard to the Sustainability Appraisal. This document should be read alongside the Deposit Sustainability Appraisal of the Local Development Plan as submitted for Examination.
- 5.2 All Matters Arising Changes have been screened to determine if a new detailed appraisal is necessary. Detailed assessments of two policy changes have been carried out and were found to be of minimal impact.
- 5.3 Following the consideration of the updated appraisals, no implications on the overall Sustainability Appraisal of the Local Development Plan were identified.
