I also agree that neither the Crown nor the Secretary of State for Defence or any Officer, Agent, Servant, Workman, or Contractor of the Crown will be liable for any damage to, or loss of, my personal property that occurs in the range area.

Part 2 Notes, conditions and warnings

- No one is permitted to enter the range area except after completing the application above, signed by the applicant and witnessed by another adult. An annual safety brief (Electronic or verbally) is also required.
- A pass, which will be issued by Castlemartin Range, must be carried at all times and may be used only by the person named on it.
- A pass may be cancelled at short notice or no notice, and must be surrendered on expiry to the Range Authorities.
- All persons entering the range, do so at their own risk. They must comply with 'Castlemartin RAC Range Byelaws 1986' and all instructions given by Range Authorities. Byelaws are posted at all main entrances to the range.
- Persons are warned of the dangers of unexploded shells and other ordnance, concealed holes, wire, target equipment, derelict buildings, fragile cliff edges. Unfamiliar objects must not be touched or disturbed in any way.
