The Sustainable Development Fund is a fund supporting community projects in and around the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park. The Fund supports community projects that contribute towards a reduction in carbon and help respond to the climate emergency.

Applicants can apply for projects to deliver the following:

a. Install renewable energy generation facilities to a community building i.e. solar panels

b. An initiative to promote reduction in carbon emissions in transport i.e. installing an electric charging point for bikes or cars or by supporting access to non-individual travel

- c. Install a community facility that minimises waste, i.e. water fountain
- d. Any other community-based carbon reduction initiative

1.2 Increased funding request

SDF/032022/1 Lawrenny Shop CIC had a total project budget £7,624 and SDF grant approved (March 2022 committee meeting) £6,100 for solar panels on community shop. Further inspection has identified the need for structural improvements to the roof which has delayed the installation of the panels, and subsequently the cost has increased. A request has been made to increase the SDF grant by £1,487 to £7,587 which is 80% of

cost of the updated panel quote of £9,484. Officer recommends approval to the grant increase.

1.5 SDF Financial position 2022/23

A total of £100,000 has been made available for grant distribution from the National Park Authority for the 2022/23 period and an additional £100,000 from Welsh Government Sustainable Landscapes Sustainable Places fund, making the total amount of grants available for 2022/23 £200,000.

Grants Approved during this financial year total £190,456

We have received 6 new applications in this financial year, but as most of the funding has been allocated applications will be looked at in the next financial year at the April meeting. Applicants have been notified of this.
