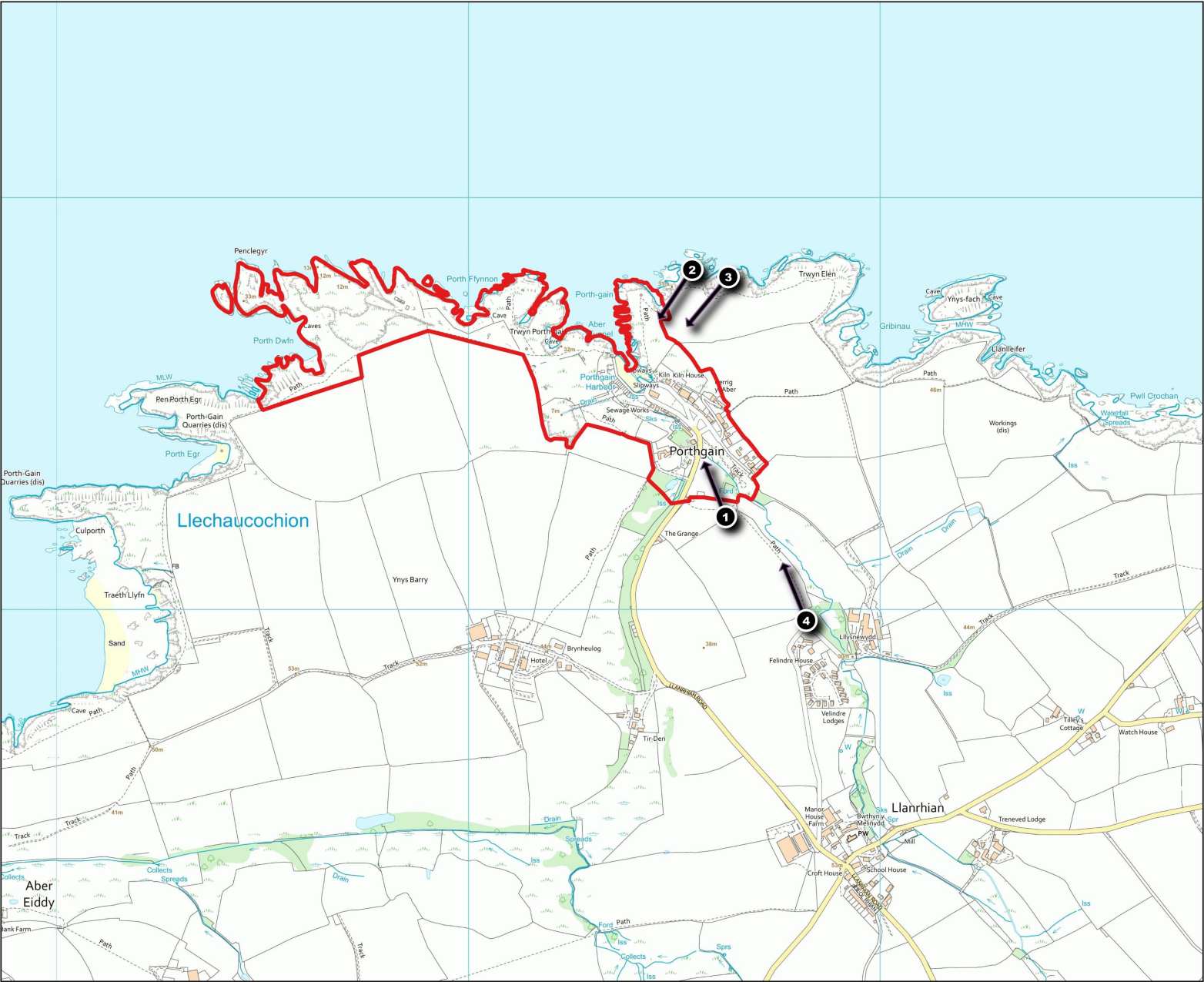
- Glimpses to an object/landmark/point of interest

Porthgain Conservation Area Designated 1997 MAP 2

1. Road entry into village showing houses on east flank of valley framed by sycamore trees.
2. Views down towards harbour, Tŷ Mawr, hoppers and Porthgain Row. Ynys faen prominent on horizon above scrub slopes. Distant fields
3. Views from headland over harbour, hoppers and Tŷ Mawr. Expansive eastern headland with brick-built industrial structures prominently visible. Panoramic sea views and also expansive distant landscape studded with farms and houses.
4. Views from Felindre towards houses on eastern side of Conservation Area with headland and sea beyond.

- A. Eastern headland prominently visible from opposite headland. Former cliff slate quarry of historic importance.
- B. Area to south east of Porthgain including Henllys and Felindre, both of historic importance; old pre-industrial track ways to Porthgain from Llanrhian, (the medieval settlement with parish church and other buildings of historic/architectural importance).
- C. Land to west of Conservation Area including granite quarries at Penclegyr, slate quarries at Abereddy, settlement of Abereddy with its industrial remains, routes and industrial tramways, Barry Island Farm of historic importance and visual prominence
