SUBJECT: Greening Agriculture Update

Purpose of Report: To Update the Members on the status of approved applications.

1.1 Background

Funding has been secured until 2025 from the Sustainable Landscapes Sustainable Places Welsh Government Grant to develop the Greening Agriculture pilot with the aim of further decarbonisation within the agricultural sector both by reducing emissions and sequestration. A criterion comprising of the elements below where agreed by Welsh Government when the funding was approved.

- Installing renewable energy equipment to power operations on the farm
- Creating carbon storage features on farms e.g. creating and regenerating hedge banks, tree planting, carbon enriched soil
- Making permanent grasslands/hay meadow (carbon storage)
- Rainwater harvesting
- Green roofs (carbon storage)
