

Officers contacted transport officers from PCC who advised that they did not hold data on the value of the coastal buses to the local economy and tourism. The graph below is taken from the report prepared by Marting Higgitt (December 2023) 'Access and travel management for the Pembrokeshire Coast: Background Report'. The graph shows monthly passenger numbers for the coastal bus services during 2019. Although this data is now several years old, it demonstrates a significant increase in passenger numbers during the summer months. This seasonal pattern suggests that the coastal bus services play an important role in supporting visitor access to the National Park, whilst also providing access for local residents.
