Notice of Appointment of Date for Exercise of Public Rights

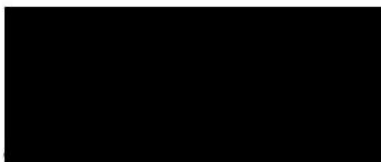

Sections 29 and 30 of the Public Audit (Wales) Act 2004 (and as further specified in the Accounts and Audit Regulations (Wales) 2014) require that the accounts and other specified documents are to be made available for public inspection. The period for public inspection is 20 full working days before the date appointed under this notice and 14 days' notice is to be given of the commencement of the period of public inspection.
