8. HSE Updates The group confirmed that the wider circulation of HSE bulletins was useful. There are specific bulletins eg wood work, agriculture, which any manager can register for directly if appropriate. HSE had recently circulated information on HAVS, manual handling, hearing protection. They are consulting on issues/regulations such as explosive substances which were less relevant to the NPA. There has been a press release this week to say that work-related fatalities in UK is at lowest level on record (133 deaths in 2013-14) and that for 8 years the UK has consistently recorded one of the lowest rates among the leading industrial nations in Europe. Although "any death at work is a death too many" (HSE).
