Background

The Development Management Section has recently received a number of Planning and Advertisement applications made by the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park Authority under The Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) and The Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisement) Regulations 1992.

The 'Origins' Project

The Origins project is part of the 'Makers of Wales' prehistoric strand of the Cadw pan-Wales interpretation plan. The funding comes from the Welsh Government's Heritage Tourism Project, which is backed with European funding. The project aims to maximise the economic value of heritage through increasing the volume, length and value of visits to Wales, linking themes of Welsh heritage at national, regional and local levels. The project will also make sure that Wales's outstanding heritage is more accessible and enjoyable to visit – for those who live in Wales and for visitors.

The funding will support the following PCNPA project:

 To enhance the site at Castell Henllys including developing it as a regional hub for the origins and prehistory of Wales. The upgrading of the Castell Henllys site, together with directional signs and interpretation panels all form part of this project.

In addition, the project is proposing the installation of interpretation panels/signs at various prehistory satellite sites throughout the North of the County within the National Park.
