

REPORT OF PLANNING OFFICER (DEVELOPMENT PLANS)

SUBJECT: PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL'S LOCAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN: FOCUSED CHANGES CONSULTATION

This report asks for authorisation for the Chief Executive, Chair and Vice-Chair of the Authority to submit any representations arising from the proposed Focused Changes to their Local Development Plan that Pembrokeshire County Council has published for consultation. The consultation closes on 11th April 2012.

Background

Pembrokeshire County Council's Local Development Plan is due to be submitted to the Welsh Government on 19th March 2012. Alongside this the Council has published Focused Changes to the Plan to update, amend and take account of representations made at the Deposit and Alternative Sites consultations. Members may recall that this Authority submitted a representation on the Deposit Plan requesting that Port areas are identified on the Proposals Map of the Plan. This representation has been incorporated into the Focused Changes to the Plan and the Inspector will consider it through the Examination process.

Officers are currently looking at the proposed Focused Changes document to assess whether any of them may impact on the National Park. As this work is not yet complete, authorisation is requested to permit the Chief Executive, Chair and Vice-Chair of the Authority to submit representations, if necessary on the Focused Changes document. The document is available for comment on Pembrokeshire County Council's website (see link below).
